- Real-time integration of clinical, production and diagnostic data to make informed decisions.
- Implementation of innovative and validated technologies to collect and test diagnostic samples.



▶▶▶▶ CONTINGENCY PLANS TO ASSURE CONSISTENT SUPPLY

- Broad network of genetic multiplication and semen production allowing for alternative sources.
- Documented experiences with disease elimination to minimize duration of health holds.

▶▶▶▶ CONSTANT COMMUNICATION BETWEEN PIC, CUSTOMERS, AND CONSULTING VETERINARIANS

- Full transparency about clinical signs and diagnostic results with customers.
- Farms immediately placed on health-hold during specific situations to protect customer herds.
- Open sharing of health concerns, issues and potential solutions with customers and the veterinary community.



▶▶▶▶ COMMITMENT TO ANIMAL WELFARE

- Continuous training of care takers and monitoring of activities.
- Proactive scientific evaluation of farm practices.



▶▶▶▶ SCIENCE-BASED BIOSECURITY, CONTINUOUSLY REVIEWED AND UPDATED

- Systematic risk assessments are performed in farms, feed mills and truck washes.
- Comprehensive plans are designed and executed to mitigate significant risk factors.
